Applicants are expected to play to a competent level, and will be accepted on a first come first serve basis, with consideration to an even spread of different types of musicians. (For example, 16 people will be accepted into the course overall but vocalists will be limited to 3 or 4, as with guitarists, bassists, etc.) It is worthwhile to note that everyone will be expected to bring their own instruments, except for drummers who we ask to bring their own sticks.
